BC CHRISTIAN ACADEMY SCHOOL BUS CODE OF CONDUCT

BC Christian Academy considers the school bus an extension of the school itself, and rules regarding behaviour are the same as in the school. School bus safety is a primary concern of the school and we reserve the right to take the necessary action to maintain a high level of safety.

BUS RIDER EXPECTATIONS:

1. At the stop:

- Arrive at your pick up point five minutes before arrival time. Buses will not wait for riders who are late.
- Conduct yourself in an orderly manner while waiting for your bus.
- Wait well back from the curb or roadway until the bus comes to a complete stop and the door is open.
- Cross in front of the bus approximately 3 metres when crossing the road.

2. On the bus:

- Board the bus in single file and in an orderly manner.
- Take your seat promptly and remain in your seat until you arrive at your destination.
- Respect and promptly obey the bus driver and the bus patrollers.
- Hold backpacks on your lap or store them safely under your seat. Do not leave any items in the aisle.
- 3. The following activities are NOT permitted on the bus:
 - Eating or drinking.
 - Interfering with bus equipment (including: fire extinguisher, safety devices, emergency doors)
 - Vandalizing or damaging the bus.
 - Throwing items out bus windows
 - Disrespectful or inappropriate language or behaviour
 - Horseplay, wrestling, or any physical altercations.
 - Putting your hands, arms, or any parts of your body out of the window at any time.
 - Any behaviour that would distract the driver from his driving duties.

DISCIPLINE POLICY:

Non compliance of the school bus policy will be reported to the school administration, and the following actions will be implemented.

- 1. First offence: the driver will write a report to the Elementary Principal
- 2. Second offence: the driver will write a report and the Elementary principal will contact parents/guardians.
- 3. Third offence: minimum one day suspension from riding privileges. The Elementary principal will consider reinstatement after satisfactory consultation with parents and driver.
- 4. Repeated offences will result in permanent removal from bus privileges. Bus fees will not be reimbursed when student(s) are removed from bus privileges.
- 5. The responsible student(s) and the parent(s)/guardian(s) will compensate for any damages and/or vandalism incurred by the student(s).
- 6. The school administration reserves the right to implement immediate suspension of riding privileges should student behaviour warrant it.
