CLASS LISTS 2024-2025

- The class lists will be posted in our Signal chat group and a link will be sent to you, IF you are a new family. Even as we forward you the latest class lists, please there may be some last minute changes as student and families settle into their routine and schedules.
- In the event of any withdrawals and/or new students joining after the start of our school year and/or current students 'graduating' from ITC 1 to ITC 2 or ITC 2 to GDC, there may potentially be some students switched between ITC classes. Parents/Guardians will be informed prior to making any changes.
- There is an additional staff assigned to all our classrooms however, please be aware that there may be occasions when a staff will need to switch between programs in the event of other staff absences due to vacation, illness, etc. in order to maintain the teacher to student ratios at all times.
- The names and contact information is provided here for easy access and will be also available on the Staff page of our website throughout the year.

GRADUAL ENTRY

For the first week, all <u>new</u> ITC students will attend only 2 – 3 hours per day as part of their gradual entry. Parents of new students, will stay with their child on the first day and our staff will recommend gradual increase of their times according to individual infant's needs. Please assign someone to be on standby to pick your child up in case of higher than usual anxiety the following week. Our staff will ensure that they spend as much one-on-one time possible with each new child, however, if a child continues with high anxiety, we will call the parent to have him/her picked up. *Thank you for ensuring that your child has a positive first week experience at our Centre*

TRAFFIC PROCEDURE REMINDERS

- During school times we recommend families to avoid the peak hours of 8:10 8:40am and 2:45 3:15pm (Fridays: 12:15 12:45pm). Families needing to drop-off and pick up during these times can park on Lincoln or side streets such as Killarney, etc. and walk to our facility.
- ITC families, please use the main parking lot for your Drop-off and Pick-up and try to avoid peak hours. This space is shared also with BCCA KG families and is available on a first-come basis. You may need to loop around if there are no spots available the first time.
- Families are not allowed to drive around our school building at all.
- PARKING OR STANDING IS PERMITTED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

- All ITC children to be dropped off to ITC2 room in the mornings between 7:00am 8:00am. The ITC1 teacher will collect their group from ITC2 and proceed to their own room at 8:00am.
- All ITC children may be picked up from the ITC2 room in the evenings anywhere between 5:00pm 6:00pm. The groups combine at the end of the day to ensure there are enough staff to supervise the remaining friends. Families will be notified in our Signal or EsiKidz chat group.

If you have any questions or concerns, or require further clarification, please do not hesitate to contact the ITC supervisor directly or speak with your child's teachers. We are happy to help!

EARLY DROP-OFF and LATE PICK-UP FEE

Please be punctual in dropping off and picking up your child. If your child is not collected at the end of his or her scheduled program time, there will be an additional charge of \$1.00 per minute for each additional

minute as agreed upon in the registration form. The same applies to students who are dropped off earlier than their program start-time. their program start-time.
