### **CLASS LISTS 2024-2025**

- We have noted your child's days, and grades as per our records. However, if there are any changes or missing information OR if you see an error, please bring it to our attention as soon as possible.
- Please inform us of your child's new classroom number and new classroom teacher as soon as possible to ensure our OSC team has all the information necessary for safe and smooth drop-offs & pick-ups.
- In the event of new students registering, students may be switched between OSC classes.

  Parents/Guardians will be informed prior to making any changes. There may also be occasions when the students and OSC staff will need to switch classrooms to accommodate all our students.
- As requests to switch children's classes/groups start flying in, we first ask that you please carefully read Ms. Theresa's Class Switch Request Letter regarding the process behind class placements.

Even as we forward you the latest class lists, please be aware that there may be some changes as student and families settle into their routine and schedules. The names and contact information of all the staff and supervisors are provided here for easy access.

## TRAFFIC PROCEDURE REMINDERS

During school times we recommend families to avoid the peak hours of 8:10 – 8:40am and 2:45 – 3:15pm (Fridays: 12:15 – 12:45pm). Families needing to drop-off and pick up during these times can park on Lincoln or side streets such as Killarney, etc. and walk to our facility. Families are not allowed to drive around our school building at all. PARKING OR STANDING IS PERMITTED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.

## OSC (BEFORE SCHOOL CARE) MORNING DROP-OFFS

- 6:30am 7:00am to Portable 7000
- 7:00am 8:00am to the Gym

Please use the main parking lot for your drop-off, and walk your child to the gym. Drop-off is by 8:00am the latest and our doors will close at that time as our staff must organize our students so we are able to board our buses and drop students to their respective schools in a timely manner.

- All KINDERGARTEN students will be dropped off directly to their classroom doors.
- All STUDENTS GRADE 1 & UP will be dismissed to head to their lines/classroom doors 5 minutes before their first bell.

## OSC (AFTER SCHOOL CARE) AFTERNOON PICK-UPS

- All KINDERGARTEN students will be picked up directly from their classroom doors.
- All STUDENTS GRADE 1 & UP will meet at a pre-designated meeting spot on the school grounds.

OSC Supervisors will send out a photo map of the meeting spot prior to the first day of school. If your child will not attend before school on the first day, please be sure to familiarize them with the meeting spot so they know where to meet their teachers.

• ALL students will meet in the gym after they are picked up from the various schools and the groups will be dismissed around 3:30pm with their respective teachers after roll-call.

## **PLEASE NOTE**

- There will be **NO drop-offs or pick-ups** for SD43 students other than at the school's regular bell schedule (Please see section <u>SD43 EARLY DISMISSALS</u> for further details).
- There will be **NO busing service** on the first day of school (TUE, SEP 3<sup>RD</sup>)
- In the event that students have schedules outside of their regular starting and dismissal timings, such as the first official day of class (WED, SEP 4th) and gradual entry for kindergarteners, parents will have to arrange for their own pick-up and drop-off to the center. Full day care can be provided for kindergartners during their gradual entry weeks as long as families <u>inform us ahead of time</u>. \*\*Additional fees may apply

#### Examples,

- (A) if the school bell is at 8:45am and your Kindergartener's gradual entry is from 8:45am 10:00am then Kids Club can do the morning drop-off but will not do the pick-up.
- (B) If the school's dismissal bell is at 2:45pm and your Kindergartener's gradual entry is from 1:00pm to 2:45pm then Kids Club can do the pick-up but not the drop-off.
- (C) If your Kindergartener's gradual entry is from 10:00am-11:30am then Kids Club will not do either dropoff or pick-up HOWEVER parents may drop off the Kindergartener to OSC in the morning, pick them up for their gradual entry and drop them back to the center after their gradual entry period, and the child can remain in OSC till the end of our day.
- (D) If there is no one available to do your Kindergartener's drop-off and pick-up, he/she may skip gradual entry and remain at Kids Club for the full day.

Please be sure to <u>let us know ahead of time</u> if your child needs additional care, so that we can make the appropriate arrangements. If you have any questions regarding the Kindergarten gradual entry, or other full days, etc. please be sure to contact the OSC Supervisors directly, we are happy to help!

#### ADDITIONAL FEES

- There is an additional fee of \$30.00 to cover for care when needed outside the OSC hours of 6:30-8:45am and 2:30-6:30pm (BCCA 12:35-6:30pm FRIs). This is on your child's <u>registered days</u> and includes pro-d days, early dismissal, kindergarten gradual entry, etc.
- For <u>drop-in</u> on days your child is not registered for, there is a fee of \$32.00 for 4 hours or less, and \$57.00 for the full day. Drop-in spaces are based on availability.
- Additional fees will be automatically withdrawn with the monthly fee for the *following month*. i.e. for a Pro-D day attended in April, your account will be charged in May. ## **EARLY DROP-OFF and LATE PICK-UP FEE**

Please be punctual in dropping off and picking up your child. If your child is not collected at the end of his or her scheduled program time, there will be an additional charge of \$1.00 per minute for each additional minute as agreed upon in the registration form. The same applies to students who are dropped off earlier than their program start-time.

### **SD43 EARLY DISMISSALS**

- We can only accommodate pick-ups for <u>school-wide</u> early dismissals. That means if just your child's class, or only grade 1, or only grades K-1 have an early dismissal, we will not do the early pick-up but pick up at the regular school dismissal time. In this situation, parents are welcome to arrange for their child(ren) to be dropped off early directly to the center. \*\*Additional fees will apply
- Some schools have the option to <u>pick up at the regular school dismissal time</u> even on listed early dismissal days. Kids Club will go with the <u>majority decision</u> and <u>only arrange for pick up at ONE time</u>. If the earlier time is chosen by the majority, the additional fee of \$30.00 will apply. Families preferring not to pay the additional fee may make alternative arrangements for their child to be picked up at the regular bell schedule and dropped off to the center for the usual after school OSC hours at no extra charge.

Supervisors or teachers will reach out via the Signal group chat a week prior to remind families about upcoming early dismissal dates and to decide upon the pick-up time.

#### **LATE PICK-UP FEE**

Please be punctual in dropping off and picking up your child. If your child is not collected at the end of his or her scheduled program time, there will be an additional charge of \$1.00 per minute for each additional minute as agreed upon in the registration form. The same applies to students who are dropped off earlier than their program start-time.

Please be aware that as we start migrating from **Procare** to the new **EsiKidz** student information system, we will move away from Signal gradually as we start using new platform for ALL our communications. We will keep you posted every step of the way so stay tuned!



## SD43 OSC parents/families will be in TWO group chats:

- (1) One group chat will be for your child's school (i.e. Leigh, Irvine, Cedar Drive, Blakeburn, Coast Salish)
  - Staff and supervisors will share updates pertaining to just each school's pro-d days, early dismissals and other non-instructional days without disturbing or confusing parents/families whose children attend other schools.
  - Please ONLY post a message if there is <u>any change from your child's usual schedule</u>. For example, if your child always attends on Monday you do NOT need to inform us your child needs pick up on Monday. Only inform us if your child is not coming on one of their usual/registered days or is doing a drop-in on a day they are not usually registered for.
- (2) One group chat will be for your child's OSC class (i.e. OSC 2, 3, 5, 6 or 7)
  - Staff and supervisors will share group photos, pick up location at the end of the day as well as any news, updates or requests for that group's special activities and events.

### KIDS CLUB EARLY CLOSURES AT 5:30PM (3:00PM CHRISTMAS EVE)

Our center has six scheduled early closures through-out the year. They are slated every other month, on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday, and will occur in 2024-2025 as follows. *The only exception will be on Tuesday, December 24<sup>th</sup> when we close at 3:00pm.*
