Last year, BCCA was excited to embark on a new journey that aligns with our mission to serve, grow, and honour God in everything we do. Last year we began this journey, seeking \$50,000 to go towards a new electric bus. We are pleased to report that families responded in an overwhelming way and we were successful in raising \$87,000. At the time, BCCA was looking to raise funds to support the annual lease, insurance, maintenance and inspection costs. Because of the generous response from our BCCA families and friends last year, and the reduction in securing an electric bus (now at \$170,000), we invite you to continue this journey through our revised **Electric Bus Capital Campaign,** where BCCA is now striving to raise the remaining \$73,000 to completely pay for the electric bus and have it available to us by early next year!

BCCA is taking a bold step toward a cleaner, and more sustainable future for our students, community, and world.

WHY GO ELECTRIC?

Our current fleet of buses is vital to our school community, providing safe transportation for hundreds of students each day. However, they also contribute to air pollution, noise, and rising fuel costs. Transitioning some of our buses to electric offers significant benefits, including:

• **Cleaner Air**: Electric buses produce zero emissions, reducing our carbon footprint and helping improve the air quality in our community.

 - Lower Operational Costs: With fewer moving parts and less maintenance, electric buses save on long-term costs, allowing us to redirect funds to other areas that support our students' growth.
